MOTHERFLUTTERS is a project created by two brothers André Cameira (flute/voice) and Filipe Cameira (guitar/voice/programming). For more than 20 years, they studied and taught music together, were part of classical music groups and played in some bands (Moullinex, Suite), until they decided to go on a solo adventure. When the European Debt crisis hit their home country, Filipe went to London and André stayed in Portugal. Ironically, that's when everything began for them...

In 2017 they started composing via Facetime, Skype and WhatsApp sending each other their own recording sessions and ideas. Later on, Filipe moved to Qatar, where he currently lives, but not even the 7500km distance was able to separate the two brothers. Music kept them together...

Their debut album TOGETHER (2023), recorded between Portugal, England, and Qatar, quickly positioned them as one of the most promising Portuguese independent projects. Singles like "Find Love", "I Wanna Be" and "One Day" reached #1 on Antena 3's TOP30 A3.30, while "Time to Time" was voted among the best Portuguese songs of 2022. International airplay followed, with their tracks entering the Top 40 of QBS Radio.

LIVE SHOWS



They have been recently invited to perform at one of the most important festivals in Europe: NOS Alive, Oeiras (Portugal), with artists such as Muse, Olivia Rodrigo and Benson Boone. They have also participated in several festivals in Portugal, such as: Festival Bons Sons (Cem Soldos), Festival N2 (Chaves), Festival dos Canais (Aveiro), Pôr do Sol no Castelo de São Jorge (Lisbon), Festa dos Tabuleiros (Tomar), TiMilha (Pombal), among others. They have also integrated the programming of some of the most emblematic venues in the country: MusicBox (Lisbon), Maus Hábitos (Porto), Bang Venue (Torres Vedras), StereoGun (Leiria), Cine-Teatro Paraíso (Tomar), Village Underground (Lisbon). The concert at MusicBox Lisboa was considered one of the best concerts of 2023 by the digital platform Música sem Capa.

2025



In 2025, they returned with a new single "DANCE", further establishing themselves as a band that blends catchy songwriting with strong dancefloor appeal. Their upcoming album, DREAMERSCLUB, promises a more experimental and alternative approach, marking their evolution while staying true to their uplifting energy.

They have also been performing across Portugal, sharing stages with local and international acts, and expanding their live setup with musicians such as Hugo Mendes (bass), Flávio Filipe (drums), and Miguel Urbano (keyboards). These collaborations add further depth and energy to their shows, reinforcing their reputation as a must-see live act.


